PRIZES

ELIGIBILITY

The contest is open to all, members and non-members, regardless of age, gender, or nationality. Every contestant can send a maximum of 2 pictures.

ENTRY PERIOD AND MODALITY

Thursday, **April 16th**, 2020 (opens at 00:00 a.m. Pacific time) to Saturday, **April 25th**, 2020 (closes at 11:00 p.m. Pacific time).

In the text body, the participant must state:

- First and Last name,
- The title of the picture(s)
- Membership status (Member or non-member)

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Photo Entries

Participants attest to the honour of their authorship of the photograph(s) they send.

Photographs must conform to the following:

- Image data files created with any device capable of taking still images, including smartphones and digital cameras.
- Images that have been retouched by using camera apps, photo editing apps, other software, etc. are accepted.
- Both color and monochrome images are accepted.
- Both portrait and landscape mode are accepted.
- Image-data file format: JPEG/150 dpi or PNG recommended

Judging

After the closing of the entry period (on 4/25), all entries will be posted on this website in the tab “MEDIA CONTENT”. Winners of each prize will be decided and revealed on the new session’s opening: 4/27.

Contest results will first be announced by email to the winners, then on our website and in a Facebook post within the following week.

Use of your pictures

Therefore, the pictures you will send to us will only be used in the purpose of this contest, except for the Jury’s prize which will remain on our website front page for a month. All the pictures collected will remain in the Media Content tab of our website until 5/15.
